

-Tractor and Exhibit Registration – is on Thursday and Friday. Stop by our tent on Friday to register your tractor, equipment, or exhibit.

-Information – Need help or have questions, look for our staff. They will have a STAFF T-shirt on. They will be able to guide you and answer any questions you may have about our show. A show brochure will be available listing the show activities for Friday and Saturday.

Safety

Any tractors or engines that are running shall not be left unattended.

There shall be no more than two (2) persons on one tractor that is moving at one time. No fender's mean no riders.

All belted equipment must have a safety rope or tape around it when in operation.

Anyone driving a tractor, or any powered equipment must be on the equipment in a position as to be in full control of the vehicle.

Mower decks must be removed, or blade belts detached on all displays.

Parents are fully responsible for their children.

Speed Limit shall not exceed 5 miles per hour on grounds for all vehicles.

No alcohol allowed on grounds during show time.

No person intoxicated, or under the influence of drugs or alcohol, shall be allowed to operate any equipment, or be close to any equipment in operation.

Drivers must be at least 16, have valid driver's license, and proof of insurance for golf carts, UTVs and similar types of vehicles to enter our grounds.

Bicycles, mopeds, go-carts, unauthorized people movers, unauthorized ATVs, UTVs, RTVs, and side by sides are not allowed on grounds or in the **Campground**.

- 1. Minimum age limit of thirteen (13) years for operating a tractor, unless the child is accompanied by an adult or parent.
- 2. People movers require a seat for each passenger.
- 3. All vehicles operating after dark must have and use proper lighting.
- 4. No glass containers allowed in display area.

Featured Tractor

Featured Tractor – Massey Harris

In 1891, Massey Manufacturing merged with A. Harris, Son & Co., Ltd. To become Massey Harris Limited, and became the largest agricultural equipment maker in the British Empire. Massey-Harris made threshing machines and reapers as well as safety bicycles.

Massey-Harris's early tractor models included the 20 horsepower Massey-Harris GP 15/22 (1930-36), 25 horsepower Massey-Harris Pacemaker (1936-39), 35 horsepower Model 101 (1938-42), Massey-Harris Pony, Model 20, Model 81, and Model 744.

During and after World Warr II, Massey Harris undertook a number of contracts to produce tractors, tanks, and self-propelled artillery vehicles for the U.S. Military. The final generation of Massey-Harris tractors, introduced immediately after World War II, included the 25 horsepower -H 22 series, the 35 horsepower M-H 33 series, the 45 horsepower M-H 44 series, and the 55 horsepower M-H 55 series. In 1952, the M-H 22 was replaced by the M-H 23 Mustang. In 1955, the 30 horsepower Massey-Harris 50 was introduced after the merger that created Massey-Harris-Ferguson.

Massey Harris also produced one of the world's first four-wheel drive tractors. In 1953, Massey-Harris merged with the Ferguson Company to become Massey-Harris-Ferguson. The name was shortened to Massey Ferguson in 1958. Massey Ferguson developed a wide range of agricultural vehicles and have a large share in the market across the world especially in Europe. In December 1957, the MF35, the first Massey Ferguson branded tractor rolled off the factory floor.

In 1959, Massey bought 100% of Landini, based in Italy. Landini has built many models for Massey over the years, especially vineyard and crawler models. Massey sold 66% to ARGO SpA in 1989, some to Iseki later on, and the final portion was sold to ARGO in 2000. In 1968, Massey Ferguson began producing a line of snowmobiles by the name Ski Whiz". The snowmobile line was discontinued in 1977, due to a decline in sales.







Featured Garden Tractor- John Deere

A History of the John Deere Garden Tractors

In 1963, John Deere added to their farm tractor family, and introduced the garden tractor model 110. The 110 was manufactured in Horicon, Wisconsin, and remains the home of Deere's lawn and garden tractors to this day. The110 had a Kohler K161 Engine, which was a 4-stroke petrol-fueled engine with 7 horsepower, and also Variable Speed Drive. It became very popular to those who didn't need a large tractor, and was only produced during the 1963 model year. The Kohler K181 replaced the K161 in 1964.

Soon, John Deere added the Model 60, which was made for suburbia, and lawn work. It offered a variety of attachments including a pull-behind sprayer, model 80 dump cart, snow blade, and snow thrower.

The Model 112 was a larger model than the 110, and had a bigger motor and wider deck. It was made for larger jobs than the 110 and 60. The John Deere 140 had a lot of power for a small machine. It had a 14 hp Kohler engine and hydrostatic transmission.

<u>In the 1970's</u>, John Deere produced the 200, 300, and 400 Series riding mowers. Features included options of 8-16 horsepower, new styled hood and grill, integral headlights, engine side panels, and power steering.

In 1984, the Model 430 was introduced and was the first tractor to combine a diesel engine with hydrostatic drive and power steering. It featured a Yanmar 3-cylinder water-cooled diesel engine. The 430 weighed 1,170 pounds, making it the heaviest and strongest John Deere machine of its time. Also, during the 1980's, the R Series and S Series were designed to work both small and large pieces of land. The R Series was good for smaller areas and had a 5-speed gear-drive transmission and tight turning radius of 27 inches. The S Series was used for bigger areas, and had an electric start, 30-inch cutting width and an 8 horsepower engine.

In the 1990's, JD created the LT133, LT Series, LX Series, and GT and GX Series. The LT Series was the favorite with wider cuts and ability to carry more fuel, and had an adjustable seat. Several attachments were available. The GT and GX Series were the ones used with more power and size for yard tasks. These could hook up to snow blowers and baggers, along with rear attachments like aerators and utility carts.

<u>Now in the 2000's</u>, John Deere developed the LA Series and the X Series. The LA models are used for medium and large lawns. They have full-length steel welded frames, headlights, comfortable operator station, and Edge Cutting systems. It also has the patented CargO Mount system allowing users to attach large baggers or other heavy rear-mounted equipment.

The X Series can transfer power to the wheels through the hydrostatic transmission to save time during operation and eliminate unnecessary gear-changing to speed up or slow down.

Special Note: From 1963 to 2018, 248 different John Deere garden tractor models were produced.

Hit & Miss Engines

What were engines used for?

In the first part of the 20th century most farms in North America did not have electrical power or farm tractors. Heavy power was provided by horses and mules. Thousands upon thousands of small gasoline-and kerosene-fueled engines were made available to provide power for operating various farm equipment, machinery and household items.

Some of the many usages were as follows:

 pumping water - sawing wood - grinding feed - shelling corn - washing clothes separating cream - running grindstones - churning butter - generating electric operating line shafts which in turn could run multiple machines at the same time.

The antique tractor drive across the Mackinac Bridge (Mighty Mac) was started by Bob Baumgras of Owosso Tractor Parts in 2007. The first crossing was in September, 2008. The first event featured 614 tractors. In 2015, 1091 tractors participated. Last year the total was 1,168 tractors. The weekend features the Bridge parade, tractor staging in St. Ignace, tractor games, food, merchandise, downtown St. Ignace tractor parade, music, and lots of conversations with fellow tractor families. The Mackinac Bridge is a five-mile span over the Straits of Mackinac that connect Michigan's Upper and Lower Peninsulas. It opened for travel on November 1, 1957. The antique tractor drive starts off in Mackinaw City, Michigan, and travels over the bridge on and through St. Ignace, Michigan. Tractors are staged on the Mackinaw City side to begin the parade, and at the end of the event are staged at downtown St. Ignace for a Friday and Saturday showing to the public. The bridge crossing is always the Friday after Labor Day. The Old Iron Club participated last year with 27 drivers and 16 buddy riders crossing the bridge. Several tractors had buddy riders: a passenger on the tractor with the driver.
