

Featured Vractor-Minneapolis Moline

The Minneapolis Moline Power Implement Company was established in 1929. It was formed by the union of three agricultural companies: the Moline Plow Company, established in 1852; Minneapolis Threshing Company, established in 1887; Minneapolis Steel and Threshing Company, established in 1902. In 1910, they started to produce a heavy weight line of road builders known as the Twin City Tractors. They would include several Twin City tractors into their own models and continue designing innovative new models for the next 30 years. In 1951, MM acquired the Avery farm equipment line. MM was purchased by White Motor Company in 1972, and the last use of the MM badge was used in 1974. The White Motor company was ultimately purchased in 1991 and continues today under AGCO.





Interview with Roger Hinton

Our featured Minneapolis Moline tractor pictures are of tractors owned by Mr. Roger Hinton. Roger was raised as a boy on a farm in Vestaburg. His family moved to McBride in 1972. He retired after 35 years as a telephone lineman. It was during this time that his collection started, with the purchase of his first Minneapolis Moline for \$50. Roger's collection now numbers 15! Roger and his wife, Deborah, now enjoy going to tractor swap meets, participating in tractor shows, rides, and parades. They have ridden on a tractor across the Mackinac Bridge five times and are looking forward to another crossing this year.

Featured Garden Wractor-Gase

Case garden tractors came into existence in 1965, after the purchase of Colt Garden Tractors/Colt Equipment in late 1964. Production began with the 1965 Case 130 and 180. Both were powered with the reliable Kohler K-Series engine with 10 and 12 HP respectively. The Colt tractors remained in production through 1965 and 1966 but the decision to stop producing Colts came in the summer of 1966. In late 1983, Case sold their garden tractor division to Jack Ingersoll, and the former Outdoor Power Equipment Division of Case in Winneconne, Wisconsin became Ingersoll Tractor Company. Initially, the badging on the tractors remained predominantly CASE during the transition period, but the Ingersoll brand became more and more prevalent during 1985 and 1986. By 1987, the Case name was permanently gone.







Interview with Lanny Withey

Lanny Withey has been a collector of Case garden tractors for many years. He was raised on his family farm, and after high school graduation in 1980, and working for 1 1/2 years at Bollingers, started farming the farm with his brother. They milked up to 90 head and raised beans and corn, using the farm tractors. Lanny bought his first Case 446 garden tractor in 2000. In 2004, he started working for Tri-County Electric and delivers propane. He figures he has owned more than 25 Case garden tractors, including an Ingersoll, 2 cubs, a Panzer and a Jacobson. He and his wife, Monica, still live on the family farm. He gardens with his Case 446, and has a rare Case 107, which was made only one year. Lanny enjoys displaying his garden tractors at tractor shows and belonging to the Old Iron Antique Tractor Club. A sample of his Case garden tractors are above.



Featured Engline: Michigan Built Englines

Hit and Miss and throttle governed engines are a type of internal combustion engine that is controlled by a governor to only fire at a set speed. These engines were conceived in the late 19th century and produced by various companies from 1900s through approximately the 1940s.

Michigan built engines were chosen to be featured at the 2021 show. A few engine names were obtained along with where in Michigan they were made. This is by no means "all" Michigan built engines.




- -Tractor and Exhibit Registration is on Thursday and Friday. Stop by our tent on Friday to register your tractor, equipment, or exhibit.

- -Lost & Found items will be at the tent.




- -Pets Unless you have a Service Dog, please leave pets at home. Never leave a pet in a vehicle.

Any tractors or engines that are running shall not be left unattended. There shall be no more than two (2) persons on one tractor that is moving at one time. No fender's mean no riders.

All belted equipment must have a safety rope or tape around it when in operation.

Anyone driving a tractor, or any powered equipment must be on the equipment in a position as to be in full control of the vehicle.

Mower decks must be removed, or blade belts detached on all displays. Parents are fully responsible for their children.

Speed Limit shall not exceed 5 miles per hour on grounds for all vehicles.

No alcohol allowed on grounds during show time.

No person intoxicated, or under the influence of drugs or alcohol, shall be allowed to operate any equipment, or be close to any equipment in operation.

Drivers must be at least 16, have valid driver's license, and proof of insurance for golf carts, UTVs and similar types of vehicles to enter our grounds.

Bicycles, mopeds, go-carts, unauthorized people movers, unauthorized ATVs, UTVs, RTVs, and side by sides are not allowed on grounds or in the campground.

- 1. Minimum age limit of thirteen (13) years for operating a tractor, unless the child is accompanied by an adult or parent.
- 2. People movers require a seat for each passenger.
- 3. All vehicles operating after dark must have and use proper lighting.
- 4. No glass containers allowed in display area.
















All Welcome!







The antique tractor drive across the Mackinac Bridge (Mighty Mac) was started by Bob Baumgras of Owosso Tractor Parts in 2007. The first crossing was in September 2008. The first event featured 614 tractors. In 2015, 1091 tractors participated. In 2019 the total was 1,168 tractors. The weekend features the Bridge parade, tractor staging in St. Ignace, tractor games, food, merchandise, downtown St. Ignace tractor parade, music, and lots of conversations with fellow tractor families. The Mackinac Bridge is a five-mile span over the Straits of Mackinac that connect Michigan's Upper and Lower Peninsulas. It opened for travel on November 1, 1957. The antique tractor drive starts off in Mackinaw City, Michigan, and travels over the bridge on and through St. Ignace, Michigan. Tractors are staged on the Mackinaw City side to begin the parade, and at the end of the event are staged at downtown St. Ignace.


